
For this year we completed 14,450 Surgeries, 1,20,150 Screenings, and our free of cost Surgeries were 7830. ICARE participated in the World's Largest Vaccination Programme from 3 March 2020 till 31 March and we completed 4500 Vaccinations.

Our Dadri Centre NTPC-ICARE Bhajan Lal Eye Hospital also began operations, located in rural area of Nagla Chamroo, Dadri, Uttar Pradesh we have equipped this hospital with state of the art diagnostics and surgical microscopes, along with comfortable waiting & recovery areas. We also started a vision Centre in Dadri town.

The Outreach programme which extended to 200 Km, was one of the largest in North India, though now with the pandemic, we have reimagined our outreach programme and process' for charitable patients.

I would like to thank all our Donors, Patients, Dedicated Doctors and staff, who recognise our contribution to society over the last 27 years & continue to support us now and in the challenging times ahead.

e began our new financial year in the CoVID pandemic. This made us rethink our strategy and process towards community operations, with restrain of admitting patients during these difficult times, we were able to ,with certain, Innovations one such beiong; starting daycare surgeries. Instead of admitting them for approximately two and a half days. The next day they are examined by staff in our local vision Centre in that area. This helped us add a lot of surgeries during COVID times much beyond our expectations. I am confident we will prevail in the coming months. Despite the challenges we opened two more vision Centre's. Our Khurja unit, continued throughout the pandemic.

The hospital garnered several appreciation awards from NOIDA Authority (presented by CEO NOIDA Authority), for our work during the pandemic. We also donated in excess of 16,000 bottles of sanitisers, 500 N95 masks, 100 PPE kits, 750 Face shields to NOIDA Authority, Police, & other emergency services. With COVID restrictions, making medical education online, it opened opportunities for our consultants to participate speak at a number of CME's, National & International.

Dr Kusum & Mr Viney Sahgals' generous donation, in building the Paramhansa Yoganand Charity Wing . The 2500 sqft, part of the building made of clay bricks had over lived its life & was lying idle as it was declared unsafe This is where the Sahgal's undertook to rebuild this space into a two storey structure-increasing infrastructure to approximately 8000 sqft. The building has two lifts, and is totally air conditioned, with air handling unit, a first of its kind in India. This building is also provided with state of the art dining hall , with separate kitchen, which also includes a sperate OPD block for charity patients. This has helped increase bed strength from 70 beds to 150 beds. We are able to treat our patients with lot of dignity, which they rightfully deserve. However, sadly, we lost Prof (Dr) Kusum Sahgal in December 2020. The Sahgals Paramhansa charitable wing is dedicated to Dr Kusum Sahgal.

In keeping with our Vision & Mission to use the latest technology. The hospital this year inducted 23 types of equipment; First in Asia Legion Phaco Machine, New HVF Analysers, Laser machines, Ocular surface analyser (OSA), Lumera Microscope, Zeiss OCTA etc as well as upgrading our current investigative equipment.

Our DNB programme has trained over 74 students to become Ophthalmologists ,Short Term Phacoemulsification Training programme has trained 539 Indian & 50 Foreign Doctors over the years.





COMMUNITY SERVICES

DURING COVID ERA

The aftermath of the COVID-19 virus has had a very significant impact on ophthalmology in India. But this also is an opportunity for us to reinvent the ways we have been working. ICARE has worked on new approaches for planning efficiencies for reaching out to more beneficiaries with limited resources.

WALK-INOPD

Patients from semi urban and rural surroundings requiring eye treatment reach to us in Free OPD section at the Base Hospital Noida, Secondary Hospitals at Khurja in Bullandshahr district, Dadri at Gautam Budh Nagar and Swai Madhopur at Rajasthan.

VISION CENTER MODEL

ICARE adapted a new model of mobilizing beneficiaries from the Vision Centres to the Base and Secondary Centres for treatment and surgical intervention. The Vision Centre team organizes the patients' referrals to the hospital, reaching out to family members in the community, arranging transportation to the hospital, and systematically removing the barriers that kept the patient from receiving surgery. The combined effort of both the Vision Centres and the base or referral hospital reduces the load of visual disability in the community.

GOVT. TIE UP

Most of the Govt facilities were occupied treating COVID-19 patients and the needy people were being neglected for other medical treatment. ICARE took a step to address this issue and be a helping hand of the Govt. by tying up with the district authorities for providing modern ophthalmic care and started mobilizing patients from the Primary Health Centers (PHCs), after their preliminary examinations and those requiring surgical interventions were picked up by ICARE following all the safety protocols for the prevention of COVID-19.

PERFORMANCE IN COMMUNITY SERVICES

Community outreach program at ICARE contributes to more than 65% (approx 2/3 of Total Surgeries) of the total ophthalmic surgeries. We provide free eye care to villages in Uttar Pradesh, Haryana, Rajasthan and Slums of Delhi (through our outreach program). Our eye camps target underprivileged people residing in remote rural areas who cannot afford eye care. This year we opened a new secondary center at Dadri. Our aim is to reach out to as many people as possible to prevent curable blindness.





CASE STUDIES

Salma D/o Zakir Hussain MRD - 0P55384 Address – Village Nithari, Sector 31, Noida, U.P Operated Eye – Right Eye (PHACO+PCIOL) Operation Type – Cataract





Salma daughter of Jakir Hussain is 12 years old girl, lives in village Nithari, Sector 26, district Gautam Budh Nagar, Uttar Pradesh. She is the youngest daughter of the five children born to Jakir Hussain. Salma's father has a small iron welding garage. Salma once complained about her diminishing eyesight with her mother, her mother thought she was making excuse to escape from her studies. They neglected her eye condition for a year to which Salma's teacher complained about her poor performance in reading and writing and suggested her father to get her eye tested. Jakir could make out that there is something wrong in Salma's eye and brought his daughter for an eye test at ICARE on 2nd November, 2020.

Salma underwent a detailed eye examination and was found having cataract in the right eye, she could only read through finger count. The doctor advised for the surgery. On 3rd November, 2020 she was admitted for the surgery under General Anaesthesia. The next day, the patch was removed and post-operative examination, Salma with an excitement of seeing things clearly hugged her father with a bright smile and thanked everyone. Jakir is eagerly looking forward to see Salma exceling in her studies and making everyone proud with her achievements.

CASE STUDIES

Manju D/o Amit Kumar MRD – 049507 Address – 17/157 Kalyanpuri, Delhi -110091 Operated Eye – Left Eye Operation Type – DCR (Dacryocystorhinostomy)



Manju, ten-year-old girl, studying in class third in a Govt. recognized school is the third child of Amit Kumar, who works a painter living in the slums of Kalyanpuri, Delhi. His eldest son is handicapped, can't walk and talk, he has some hope from his second daughter (Renu) who is sharp in studies and is studying in class 8th, she also helps her mother in household chores, taking care of the aged grandfather and other siblings. Manju's mother is very hard working, she works alone in the field and take cares of the family, while Amit is away for earning some extra money for the family in the urban locations of Delhi.

Manju being the naughtiest amongst the siblings is close to his father, she got hurt two years ago by an electric fan which was being used by a neighbour for winnowing the rice seed grains from the husk. Manju was rushed to a nearby clinic where they gave her some medicine and ointment for healing the eye. After few months, Manju's mother noticed that her left eye was full of tears; sometimes it becomes difficult for Manju to open her left eye due to mucopurulent discharge. Manju's mother shared the issue with her husband and requested for getting her treatment done for saving her eyesight. Amit without any delay brought her daughter from

the village to Delhi, for getting the eye treatment done at AIIMS, where Manju initial check-up was done and given a 6 moths waiting time for free surgery. Amit went hopeless and shared his concern with one of his neighbour.

Fortunately, his neighbour guided him to get his daughter eye checked at ICARE Eye Hospital. Next day he reached ICARE base hospital with his daughter, the doctor thoroughly checked her eye and found out that her left eye tear duct got blocked and needed a surgical intervention for creating a new tear drain between her eye and nose. The surgery was planned after getting her physical fitness on 13th January, 2021. Her left eye surgery was successfully done for Dacryocystorhinostomy (DCR) under general anaesthesia. On 14th January, 2021 her post-operative examination was conducted for the further observations, the new tear duct was successfully created.

Manju's father was very happy to know that his daughter will now be able to wake up in the morning without sticky eye. When asked about his opinion of ICARE, Amit says, "There are no words to thank them as ICARE supported my daughter surgery without even knowing us."

CATARACT AND ANTERIOR SEGMENT SERVICES

ICARE is the first in Asia and the only Eye Hospital to have the new Legion Phaco system. The cataract team is dedicated and focused towards eradicating curable blindness caused by cataract. This year we performed record 11,704 surgeries. Lead by Dr Saurabh Choudhry we train DNB students, we also train short and long term fellows in this ophthalmic sub specialty.

GLAUCOMA

Glaucoma is a subspecialty in ophthalmology which deals with eye diseases that damage the optic nerve and results in a decrease in field of vision. Glaucoma affects approximately 60 million people globally and is the second most common cause of blindness. Our Glaucoma expert team provides full spectrum of care ranging from Medical therapy, Laser treatment, Traditional glaucoma surgery, Glaucoma valve implant to latest Minimally Invasive Glaucoma Surgeries (MIGS) for patients of all ages. We also provide training to ophthalmologists from different parts of country in glaucoma management and are part of ongoing research in glaucoma at national and international level.

Cornea services at ICARE has three well trained and experienced specialists. The department is aided by a well-equipped eye bank which is the only eye bank in Noida. A tear science lab is being established at ICARE which can diagnose and treat all types of ocular surface disorders including dry eyes. It has the latest technology in diagnostics such as the Lipiview and the latest treatment modality Lipiflow. Advanced diagnostic tools like thePentacam, Orbscan, Specular microscope and iTrace helpdiagnosis various corneal disorders. Highly specialized corneal surgeries including corneal transplantation, Femto Laser assisted corneal procedures are effectively performed by the corneal team. RETINA

The Department of Vitreo Retina and Uvea services comprises of a team of experienced fellowship trained experts to deal with the most complex retinal and uveal diseases. The department has access to state of the art technology such as Indo cyanine green angiography, fundus fluorescein angiogram, optical coherence tomography, ocular ultrasound, retinal lasers, and advanced surgical systems such as Constellation with MIVS. The recently acquired Heidelberg Imaging System, the most advanced system in the world, has further augmented our diagnostic facilities, benefitting our patients. The Department has one of the most advanced Retinal services in Delhi-NCR and has a large referral base. Diabetic Retinopathy Services: The Institute offers the entire range of facilities for the diagnosis and treatment of Diabetic Retinopathy. The department conducts regular patient education programs. The center is a tertiary referral center for the management of advanced diabetic retinopathy. Retinopathy of Prematurity (ROP) Clinic: This condition which affects premature infants immediately after birth could be a blinding disease if not detected or left untreated at an early stage. Ophthalmologists trained in the treatment of ROP examine the eyes of premature infants in various neonatal centers in hospitals across the city and also in neighboring districts for early detection of this condition. The Institute provides laser treatment for this particular condition and also surgical expertise for advanced cases.

PAEDIATRIC OPHTHALMOLOGY

The paediatric ophthalmology and strabismus department treats infants and children upto 16 years of age. The department is well equipped with facilities to manage disorders of vision including refractive errors (need for eye glasses), lazy eye, strabismus (squint/crossed eyes), eye infections, allergies, watering from the eyes due to blocked tear ducts and childhood cataracts and other disorders. The department co-manages disorders like lid-drooping and retinopathy of prematurity with other specialty departments. We also have a fully functional Orthoptic facility with computerized vision therapy to treat eye muscle weakness.







We celebrate National Eye Donation fortnight from 25 August to 8 September every year.







AWARENESS DRIVE

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation the activities related to the Eye Bank were discontinued. No awareness drive could be carried out during this time period.

During this Pandemic year ICARE also prepared and contributed towards fight against COVID-19. We started capacity building very quickly to prepare ourselves for the upcoming fight. Protocols were prepared afresh, some were amended, implementation ,monitoring and most importantly maintaining these protocols was whole new experience all together. It was clear from start that this pandemic will not only test our organisation resilience but also every individual. We are gratified by the fact that ICARE team is strong and committed to quality patient care.

Commitment to care: Steps against COVID-19

Our first step was to constitute precautionary protocols for COVID-19, on basis if Government guidelines. HIC Committee conducted numerous meetings to discuss and finalize these protocols in line with International (CDC), National (MoHFW) and Professional (All India Ophthalmology Society-AIOS) Guidelines.

Red Eye Clinic:

It was step-up in June 2020, to examine and treat infectious patients. Separate area, Clinical and non-clinical staff designated for Red Eye clinic. Infrastructure and process protocols required for this project were discussed and decided by the HIC Committee.

Teleconsultation:

We knew from start that need for Teleconsultation will arise in due time, to cater the needs of existing patients and new patients. Thus, we started Teleconsultation in June 2020 and continuous till date.

All hospital staff were vaccinated twice by March, 2021. From 3rd March 2021, we are participating in the World's largest vaccination programme we have not had any AEFIs.


