have great satisfaction, in releasing our Annual report for Financial Year 2021-2022. The Pandemic has been a great teacher, we have had to change & reimagine our Strategy & Operations. Our vigorous participation in the Worlds' largest vaccination programme, culminated in vaccinating 18,251 doses (14,413 Covishied & 3838 Covaxin), including 1700 free of cost vaccinations for the poor/underprivileged.

Compared to the previous year the financial & Operational challenges, eased to an extent. Our changed operational model, retention of our workforce, ensured, we scaled back rapidly, with a greater number of surgeries than anticipated. The private wing for the first time exceeded 10,000 surgeries.

This year in charity we screened 85,589 patients and performed 13,257 surgeries, and in the private wing we screened 1,03,865 patients and performed 10,107 surgeries. A cumulative total of 1,89,454 patients screened and 23,364 surgeries performed, this was almost in line with pre-pandemic levels.

Our Secondary centres, Dadri NTPC-ICARE Bhajanlal Eye Hospital & Khurja ICARE Rotary Sewa Trust, returned back to normal operations.

Our outreach programme, was remodeled in partnership with NGOs & government PHCs, which contributed prescreened patients, enhancing our surgery conversion from 9% to 15%.

I take this opportunity to express my appreciation to our Donors, Patients, dedicated Doctors & Staff , who have worked continuously and dynamically throughout the pandemic.

I wish you good Health and thank you for being part of ICARE's 29 Year Journey.

# ICARE'S ACHIEVEMENT OVER THE 29 YEARS




ICARE Eye Hospital & Postgraduate Institute has been working in the field preventive and curative eye healthcare since 1993. The hospital has screened 43.70 lakhs and restored eye sight of 3.50 lakhs patients till March, 2022. Out of these total numbers almost 62 percent of work is for Charity, making it an organization with the largest proportion of charity compared to any other ophthalmic non-government hospitals. In the FY 21-22, ICARE examined 189454 patients and performed 23367 surgeries. These milestones have been achieved with the help of corporates, PSUs, NGOs and individual donors.

Ishwar Charitable Trust ('ICT' for short) manages a holistic eye care facility and is the name and style of ICARE Eye Hospital and Post Graduate Institute.

In our 29 years of existence, we at ICARE Eye Hospital have touched the lives of 43.70 lakhs by eye screening and restored eye sight of 3.50 lakhs patients till March, 2022. "The free surgeries were achieved with the help of revenue generated from the surplus generated from our paid wing and help received from individuals, corporate, NGOs and other well-wishers".

# **COMMUNITY SERVICES**

#### DURING COVID ERA

The aftermath of the COVID-19 virus has had a very significant impact on ophthalmology in India. But this also is an opportunity for us to reinvent the ways we have been working. ICARE has worked on new approaches for planning efficiencies for reaching out to more beneficiaries with limited resources.

#### WALK-IN OPD


Patients from semi urban and rural surroundings requiring eye treatment reach to us in Free OPD section at the Main Hospital Noida, Secondary Hospitals at Khurja in Bullandshahr district, Dadri at Gautam Budh Nagar and Swai Madhopur at Rajasthan.

#### VISION CENTER MODEL

ICARE adapted a new model of mobilizing beneficiaries from the Vision Centres to the Base and Secondary Centres for treatment and surgical intervention. The Vision Centre team organizes the patients' referrals to the hospital, reaching out to family members in the community, arranging transportation to the hospital, and systematically removing the barriers that kept the patient from receiving surgery. The combined effort of both the Vision Centres and the base or referral hospital reduces the load of visual disability in the community.

#### **GOVERNMENT TIE-UP**

Most of the facilities were occupied treating COVID-19 patients and the needy people were being neglected for other medical treatment. ICARE took a step to address this issue and be a helping hand of the Govt. by tying up with the district authorities for providing modern ophthalmic care and started mobilizing patients from the Primary Health Centers (PHCs), after their preliminary examinations and those requiring surgical interventions were picked up by ICARE following all the safety protocols for the prevention of COVID-19.



#### CATARACT AND ANTERIOR SEGMENT SERVICES

ICARE is the first in Asia and the only Eye Hospital to have the new Legion Phaco system. The cataract team is dedicated and focused towards eradicating curable blindness caused by cataract. This year we performed 6797 cataract surgeries. Lead by Dr Saurabh Choudhry we train DNB students, we also train short and long term fellows in this ophthalmic sub specialty.

#### **GLAUCOMA**

Glaucoma is a subspecialty in ophthalmology which deals with eye diseases that damage the optic nerve and results in a decrease in field of vision. Glaucoma affects approximately 60 million people globally and is the second most common cause of blindness. Our Glaucoma expert team provides full spectrum of care ranging from Medical therapy, Laser treatment, Traditional glaucoma surgery, Glaucoma valve implant to latest Minimally Invasive Glaucoma Surgeries (MIGS) for patients of all ages. We also provide training to ophthalmologists from different parts of country in glaucoma management and are part of ongoing research in glaucoma at national and international level.

#### CORNEA

Cornea services at ICARE has three well trained and experienced specialists. The department is aided by a well-equipped eye bank which is the only eye bank in Noida. A tear science lab is being established at ICARE which can diagnose and treat all types of ocular surface disorders including dry eyes. It has the latest technology in diagnostics such as the Lipiview and the latest treatment modality Lipiflow. Advanced diagnostic tools like the Pentacam, Orbscan, Specular microscope and iTrace help diagnosis various corneal disorders. Highly specialized corneal surgeries including corneal transplantation, Femto Laser assisted corneal procedures are effectively performed by the corneal team. Autologous stem cell transplantation procedures such as simple limbal stem cell transplantation is also being done by our trained surgeons.

#### **RETINA**

The Department of Vitreo Retina and Uvea services comprises of a team of experienced fellowship trained experts to deal with the most complex retinal and uveal diseases. The department has access to state of the art technology such as Indo cyanine green angiography, fundus fluorescein angiogram, optical coherence tomography, ocular ultrasound, retinal lasers, and advanced surgical systems such as Constellation with MIVS. The recently acquired Heidel berg Imaging System, the most advanced system in the world, has further augmented our diagnostic facilities, benefitting our patients. The Department has one of the most advanced Retinal services in Delhi-NCR and has a large referral base. Diabetic Retinopathy Services: The Institute offers the entire range of facilities for the diagnosis and treatment of Diabetic Retinopathy. The department conducts regular patient education programs. The center is a tertiary referral center for the management of advanced diabetic retinopathy. Retinopathy of Prematurity (ROP) Clinic: This condition which affects premature infants immediately after birth could be a blinding disease if not detected or left untreated at an early stage. Ophthalmologists trained in the treatment of ROP examine the eyes of premature infants in various neonatal centers in hospitals across the city and also in neighboring districts for early detection of this condition. The Institute provides laser treatment for this particular condition and also surgical expertise for advanced cases.

The department also offers cosmetic solutions including Botox, fillers, ocular prosthesis, and reconstruction. 

# NEURO OPHTHALMOLOGY

Neuro Ophthalmology is the subspecialty that deals with disorders of the optic nerve. Common disorders include optic neuritis, Ischemic Optic neuropathies and Traumatic optic neuropathy. Diagnosis of these disorders requires electrophysiological tests such as VEP/ERG and EOG. At ICARE we have state of the art technology and trained doctors to help patients facing these issues.

# PAEDIATRIC OPHTHALMOLOGY

The paediatric ophthalmology and strabismus department treats infants and children upto 16 years of age. The department is well equipped with facilities to manage disorders of vision including refractive errors (need for eye glasses), lazy eye, strabismus (squint/crossed eyes), eye infections, allergies, watering from the eyes due to blocked tear ducts and childhood cataracts and other disorders. The department co-manages disorders like lid-drooping and retinopathy of prematurity with other specialty departments. We also have a fully functional Orthoptic facility with computerized vision therapy to treat eye muscle weakness.

Refractive services is a progressive team working diligently to provide freedom from spectacles. We provide Lasik, C-Lasik, ICL, PRK after conducting comprehensive tests to check the eligibility of the patient for a particular procedure. The team is led by Dr Saurabh Choudhry and has experienced doctors. The department has also trained surgeons for Lasik Procedure. Lasik surgery helps correct vision issues, however reading glasses may still be required with age.

We celebrate National Eye Donation fortnight from 25 August to 8 September every year.







# AWARENESS DRIVE

Due to the COVID-19 pandemic situation the activities related to the Eye Bank were discontinued. No awareness drive could be carried out during this time period.

It was clear from start that this pandemic will not only test our organisation resilience but also every individual. We are gratified by the fact that ICARE team is strong and committed to quality patient care.

#### Commitment to care: Steps against COVID-19

Our first step was to constitute precautionary protocols for COVID-19, on basis if Government guidelines. HIC Committee conducted numerous meetings to discuss and finalize these protocols in line with International (CDC), National (MoHFW) and Professional (All India Ophthalmology Society-AIOS) Guidelines.

#### Red Eye Clinic:

It was step-up in June 2020, to examine and treat infectious patients. Separate area, Clinical and non-clinical staff designated for Red Eye clinic. Infrastructure and process protocols required for this project were discussed and decided by the HIC Committee.

#### Teleconsultation:

We knew from start that need for Teleconsultation will arise in due time, to cater the needs of existing patients and new patients. Thus, we started Teleconsultation in June 2020 and continuous till date.

#### Vaccination (Covishield):

All hospital staff were vaccinated twice by March, 2021. From 3rd March 2021, We participated in the World's largest vaccination programme.

# VACCINATION DRIVE

We have continued the vaccine drive for reaching out larger population. From March, 2021 to 31st March, 2022 we have vaccinated 20690 beneficiaries, (Covishield = 16850, Covaxin = 3840). Vaccine worth Rs. 17.60 Lakhs were given free of cost to needy people, with the support from our Corporate partner – ICICI Foundation & HelpAge India - Axis Bank under CSR initiative.

# **COMMUNITY SERVICE**

ICARE was very enthusiastic for the new financial year 2021-22 but the situation that came on all too suddenly due to Second wave of COVID catching everyone unprepared. The multi-faceted activities of ICARE also slowly grounded again to a halt... almost w.e.f. 20th April, 21. All protocols such as hand washing, temperature screening, physical distancing, and eliciting travel history and so on were put in place more stringently again almost immediately to make the hospital safe for both the staff and patients.

Community Outreach from the early years, ICARE has reached out to the community through free eye camps. Today, there are two Secondary Centers in the district of Bulandshahr and Gautam Budh Nagar of Uttar Pradesh that offer out-patient care and IPD services. The model which we adapted in from 2020 during Pandemic continued - mobilizing beneficiaries from the Vision Centres to the Base and Secondary Centres for treatment and surgical intervention.

# OPD SERVICES

ICARE provides free of cost ophthalmic services to poor patients in neighbouring villages of Delhi, in the state of Uttar Pradesh, Haryana & Rajasthan. We organize screening camps to reach out to people in need of ocular services as well as to create awareness. We also run a OPD at our Main Hospital, Noida where approximately 100 patients are examined without any charges. Patient screening was done in a systematic way and mass screening was restricted for controlling the spread of COVID disease.


# SURGERIES CONDUCTED (COMMUNITY)

The COVID-19 pandemic has profoundly impacted the delivery of ophthalmic care in the country. Hospitals have seen a drastic decline in outpatient visits as well as procedures, and have experienced a significant loss in revenue.

According to the National Programme for Control of Blindness (NPCB), India is home to a third of the world's visually challenged population. The country has around 12 million individuals with visual impairment as against the global total of 39 million.

The latest national survey for blindness and visual impairment carried out in India highlighted that corneal issues are the second most common cause of blindness in India after cataract. There are only two ways to manage this – preventive measures to ensure that vision problems do not occur and are not serious or integration of eye healthcare with primary healthcare centers.


Cataract cannot be treated with any medicine; eye drops or laser. The only guaranteed treatment of cataract is surgical removal of clouded natural eye lens with an artificial transparent one known as intra-ocular lens (IOL). This artificial intra-ocular lens is made up of plastic, silicone or acrylic and performs functions similar to natural lens. During the year, 93% of our surgeries were cataract and other 7% were Cornea, Glaucoma, Squint, Retina, etc.









Sanehi a 59 years old woman came to us from Anoopshahr in UP. She hails from Sambhal, in UP where she lives with her family son and grandchildren. They have a small piece of agricultural land in the village. She and her husband worked very hard for bringing up their children as they did not had enough land and had no other means of income. They had a few cattle, so they were able to provide milk to the children and eke a living by selling the milk.

She was married when she was only 16 years old. Her husband passed away few years ago. Life was stable and she has no regrets as she is being looked after well by her children.

Being an arthritic patient, her fingers have become disfigured so much so that she is unable to cook comfortably as well as carry out other domestic work. Taking strong medication for arthritis from an early age had other side effects and she developed cataract in both her eyes.

Her neighbour informed her about ICARE hospital in



Noida and she persuaded her son to take her there.

At the hospital she was diagnosed as having cataract and was advised surgery. At the hospital she underwent a complete comprehensive examination and her surgery was scheduled for the next day. After successful surgery in her right eye she was delighted when she discovered that she could now see from the operated eye. She was also very happy that she had found a facility which she could access with some ease. She also decided that she would come once again to get her other eye operated at ICARE too.

Momina, a 55 years old lady came to us form Village Nai Basti, Loni, and Ghaziabad. She is staying with her husband and a 22 year's old handicapped son. One of her son is a vegetable vendor at Baghpat, in UP and staying there with his children and wife. Her husband works as labourer and looks after her and heir disabled child. They have a small Kutcha house to live but no agricultural land.

Her husband worked so hard throughout his life alone as Momina has to look after their ailing child and could not work outside. The child needs 24x7 attendants.

Her vision started diminishing in both eyes, the left one being worse. She was more worried about his son than her and depressed over it. She did not have financial means to get herself treated in a private hospital and Govt Hospital has given her date after six months. One day she came to know about the vision centre being run by ICARE at East Delhi in the slum area. She consulted the doctors there free of cost and



she was advised to get her surgery done for left eye for cataract. She was given transport to the base hospital from the vision centre which she was never expecting.

At base hospital Noida her surgery was performed on 2nd April with IOL implant. She was so happy with her eye sight restored when her bandage opened the next day. Momina is able to oversee the house and her disabled son now. Her husband is very happy for her as she is confident again.


